



The Valentino Bucchi Foundation is pleased to announce the outcome of the 41st edition of the Valentino Bucchi Prize International Composition Competition in 2022.

The final concert, held on 11/20/2022 in the presence of the public and in live streaming at the Sala Casella in Rome as part of the artistic activities of the Accademia Filarmonica Romana, presented the works of the seven composers selected among the numerous participants, six Italian authors and one Japanese author.

The Commission formed by the Maestros: **Claudio Ambrosini, Matteo D'Amico, Mario Mary (Argentina), Rosario Mirigliano and Giorgio Nottoli**, unanimously assigned the Valentino Bucchi Prize 2022 to the composer **Davide Di Francescantonio**, born in Rome on 29/01/1999, author of the piece: "Después de una noche invisible" for piano solo.

The Commission, due to the high level of the selected works, has decided to assign Honorable Mentions to the following composers:

**Daria Baiocchi**, born in Ascoli Piceno on 04/14/1978, for the piece "Connection II" for clarinet and electronics

**Lorenzo Marino**, born in Rome on 02/23/1998, for the piece "Nuga" for Viola solo

**Matteo Tundo**, born in Potenza on 21/08/1992, for the piece "Spazio inclinato" for alto saxophone and electronics.
